**POST DISPOSITIONAL INFORMATION PURSUANT TO  
Pa.R.J.C.P.620**

1. You have the right to file a post-dispositional motion no later than ten (10) days after the imposition of disposition.
2. If you do not file a post-dispositional motion, but wish to appeal, a notice of appeal shall be file within thirty (30) days of the imposition of disposition.
3. If you file a post-dispositional motion, all requests for relief from the court shall be stated a required by Pa.R.J.C.P. 620 A(1).
4. If you file a post-dispositional motion, the judge shall decide the motion within thirty (30) days of the filing of the motion. Upon motions of a party within the thirty day disposition period, and for good cause shown, the judge may grant one thirty day extension for decision on the motion. If the judge fails to decide the motion within the time permitted, the motion shall be deemed denied by operation of law, and the clerk of courts shall enter an appropriate order, with notice to the parties on behalf of the court.
5. If a timely post-dispositional motion is filed, and you wish to appeal from the order denying your motion, a notice of of appeal shall be filed within thirty (30) days of that order.

6. Issues raised before and during adjudication shall be deemed preserved for appeal whether or not a post-dispositional motion is filed. Issues properly preserved at the dispositional hearing need not, but may, be raised again in a motion to modify disposition in order to preserve them for appeal.
7. You have the right to the assistance of counsel in preparation of any post-dispositional motion or appeal. Counsel will be appointed to represent you on the post-dispositional motion and/or appeal upon request made to the Public Defender's Office.
