**AND NOW**, this 28<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021, the Court, on April 15, 2021, having declared a judicial emergency in the 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial District of Pennsylvania through July 30, 2021;

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Paragraph A. 2. Of the 12<sup>th</sup> Amended Judicial Emergency Order is amended in that "July 2, 2021" is hereby changed to "June 27, 2021," the result being that masks and social distancing will no longer be required in the Lehigh County Courthouse or Lehigh County Magisterial District Judge offices as of June 28, 2021.
