

## DRUG AND ALCOHOL ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

You must complete a drug and alcohol assessment **PRIOR** to your next court appearance. Please refer to [www.ddap.pa.gov](http://www.ddap.pa.gov) for the most updated and accurate list of state licensed providers in your area.

- Click on “Substance Use Disorder Treatment” and search for local providers by either “Treatment Atlas” or “Care Provider Search”.
