RULES OF HOUSE ARREST

AVERHEALTH:

You MUST allocate 2 hours per day (including travel time); however, you will not be called to go everyday

COMMUNITY SELF-HELP SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDER MEETINGS:

No more than 2 ½ hours per meeting (including travel time)

GROCERY SHOPPING:

One location per week for 2 hours (including travel time)

LAUNDRY:

Once per week for 3 hours (including travel time)

BANK:

Once per week for 30 minutes

CHURCH:

One location for no more than 2 ½ hours per week; once per week (including travel time)

EMPLOYMENT:

50 hours plus travel time. MUST PROVIDE A PAYSTUB OR OTHER VERIFICATION.

HAIR CUT:

Only if you are on House Arrest for MORE THAN 30 DAYS – you are allowed 2 hours (including travel time)

ACTIVITIES YOU MUST PROVIDE VERIFICATION FOR:

1. College/technical school
2. Community Work Service – must be approved by Probation Officer
3. Doctors appointments
4. Drug and Alcohol Treatment, Mental Health Treatment, Court Ordered Programs

EMERGENCY ROOM VISITS:

During business hours contact your supervising officer; after business hours you should contact the on-call officer for approval at 610-704-6687

You are required to remain at your residence at all times unless you have submitted an approved schedule of approved activities or have been granted an emergency leave by Lehigh County Adult Probation/Parole Staff. You are confined to the area between your front door and your back door.

You are required to travel from your home to the location on your schedule. You are NOT permitted to make any additional stops that are not on your schedule.

If another adult lives in your residence, they will be required to do things such as the laundry, grocery shopping, etc.

In the event of a natural disaster or an unplanned event that leaves your home uninhabitable, you may seek alternate shelter. You must contact your Probation Officer by the next working day and provide documentation that verifies the situation.

Schedules are due by ***4 PM every Wednesday*** for the upcoming week (Monday to Sunday)
