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### ***Electronic Monitoring Information Sheet***

As a result of your conviction, you have been placed on Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest and will be required to submit a weekly schedule to either [housearrest@lehighcounty.org](mailto:housearrest@lehighcounty.org) (Lehigh County residents and Bail cases) or [lehighsupport@vigilnet.com](mailto:lehighsupport@vigilnet.com) (Out of County Transfers and Driving Under Suspension cases).

General rules:

- 1) You shall be responsible for a telephone service (landline or cell phone) and an emergency contact phone number.
- 2) You shall maintain a stable residence for the entire length of your Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest.
- 3) You will be expected to remain at home unless you provide a schedule of approved activities or have been granted an emergency leave by Lehigh County Adult Probation/Parole staff.
- 4) You will be confined to the area between your front and back doors, and will not be permitted to go outside which includes front or back porches.
- 5) You will be required to provide a new weekly schedule to Vigilnet indicating all leave and return times. Those schedules are due **every Wednesday by 4:00 pm** and will cover the following week (Monday to Sunday). Schedules can be submitted in person or electronically. If you fail to provide a schedule, you will not be permitted to leave your residence other than to report for a urine test.
- 6) You will be expected to answer and respond to all calls from the Lehigh County Adult Probation/Parole Department.
- 7) You shall refrain from consuming any alcoholic beverages, non-alcoholic beer, or any medications or mouthwash containing alcohol.
- 8) You will be responsible for the Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest equipment and will be held accountable for any theft or damage to said equipment.
- 9) You shall not move, remove, or disconnect any equipment used for Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest.
- 10) When given permission to leave your residence for approved activities, you will only be permitted to travel to and from said destination and will not be permitted to stop at any other location.

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The bracelet must be worn snug against your skin. No objects may be inserted between the skin and the bracelet. Attempts to defeat the system by wearing the bracelet improperly or by inserting objects between the bracelet and skin will be considered a violation of the house arrest program.

You must avoid using or coming into contact with products containing alcohol including, but not limited to, perfumes and colognes, after shave, hair spray, mouthwash, hand sanitizer, over the counter medications (i.e. Nyquil, cough medicine, etc.), alcohol, and non-alcoholic beer.

The bracelet is water resistant, not water proof. You may shower; however, you are not permitted to take baths, swim in a pool, or submerge the bracelet in water. Submerging the bracelet in water damages the bracelet and you will be held liable for the replacement cost.

Routine maintenance on the bracelet is required. You are expected to report to the Lehigh County Adult Probation and Parole Department promptly when maintenance is required.

If you are required to charge your bracelet and fail to do so as required, it is considered an attempt to defeat the monitoring system and is a violation of the house arrest program.

Any violation will result in removal from the program and your case will be returned to the Court for reconsideration.
