TO FILE A WRIT OF EXECUTION UPON A CONFESSED JUDGMENT COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Complete the following documents:
 - a. Praecipe for Writ of Execution/Attachment upon a Confessed Judgment
 - b. Writ of Execution/Attachment upon a Confessed Judgment
 - c. Confession of Judgment Certification
 - d. Writ of Execution Notice
- 2. If there is/are garnishee/s they must be listed in the caption and original interrogatories to the garnishee are required
- 3. The "Amount Due" on the Praecipe and Writ must be the same as or less than the total amount of judgment
- 4. The interest amount can not be calculated past the date of filing the Execution per the Hines vs. Petitt, 638 F. Supp. 1269(E.D. Pa. 1986)
- 5. Executions pertaining to different counties need one original for each county plus the required fee for each county
- 6. Personal Property- list address to serve with exact items to be executed upon
- 7. Real Estate Property list address and provide a real estate description of the property
- 8. See Fee Schedule under Writs for Filing Fee
- 9. Electronically file the completed Praecipe for Writ of Execution/Attachment upon a Confessed Judgment, Writ of Execution, Confession of Judgment Certification, and Writ of Execution Notice through the Odyssey File and Serve (OFS) system at https://pennsylvania.tylertech.cloud/ofsweb
- 10. If you wish for the Clerk of Judicial Records-Civil Division office to electronically file the documents, please provide the filing fee and a \$1.00 per page conversion fee for the e-filing service
